a. Music Director - Search Committee

- i. Good opportunity to plan and expand our music leadership
- ii. What do we want for our future for the music program to be?
- iii. We have a group of people who have said they'd like to serve on the search committee team:
 - 1. Carol Bachmeyer
 - 2. Deb Yunker
 - 3. Mike Keeter
 - 4. Others...
- iv. We need to have a well rounded search committee of people who have a broad idea of our music ministry.
- v. We don't have a clear timeline to when this committee will start. This needs to be addressed before January 2026.
- vi. We need to decide what we want to do. Full time positions for organist/choir directors? Often, we won't find both within one person. We need to think through what TYPE of roles we want to offer/promote.
- vii. Thoughts on full or part time positions...
 - Can we find people to fill these roles within this community? The cost of living in Brevard is HIGH. The reality of filling these positions with someone local is something to consider.
 - 2. BFUMC's organ is a wonderful opportunity for a musician.
 - 3. We could advertise the position through the conference & district.
 - 4. An evaluation of what we are looking for is important. These are specific skillsets & a person may be better at one role than another.
 - Ideally, this person would encourage the musical gifts that are residing within our congregation. The director needs to tap into the people who are willing to share their gifts.

 - 10. Bart's training and experience with musicians and vocalists is something we need to note

More than likely, we won't have someone completely hired on by January 2026. We need to think of different ways to get an organist in the building, whether that be full time or seasonally
